

## **MEMBERSHIP WITH ST REGULUS LADIES' GOLF CLUB**

In St Andrews there are seven golf courses that are managed by The Links Trust and all the local golf clubs play their golf competitions on all of the golf courses including The Old Course. Joining St Regulus Golf Club will mean that as a club member you will have your handicap looked after and you will be eligible to enter the club competitions. Our club subscriptions do not however cover the costs of actually playing on the golf courses. As the courses are managed by The Links Trust each player who wishes to play in our competitions must pay the green fee for the course that the competition is being played on. Some of our ladies pay the green fee each time they play but most members will apply for and purchase an annual Links Ticket. There are different categories of Links Tickets depending on where you live and which courses you wish to play on. The prices vary significantly. There are waiting lists for most of the categories (other than for residents of the town) and you would need to get in touch with The Links Trust to find out the current position for the category of ticket that would be appropriate for where you live. St Regulus Ladies Golf Club has its clubhouse on Pilmour Links. It is situated approximately mid way between the Russacks Hotel and Auchterlonies shop. There is a plaque on the wall by the side of the front door. The Clubhouse has a members' lounge/dining room and a kitchen, with locker room and showers etc, Notice boards and Admin office downstairs. There are lockers that can be used by members. We do not have catering available at the Clubhouse except on some competition days. The Clubhouse is normally unoccupied and members will visit to see the notice boards and put their names on the entry sheets etc. We have some social events but these are only occasionally.

We have a large number of competitions played throughout the winter and summer. In the summer there will be at least one competition each week and some weeks there could be two or even three competitions as well as match play events. We play the competitions on all of the courses including The Old Course. For example, we have four monthly medals, the medal finals, the club championship and three other competitions that are played on The Old Course throughout the summer months. We also have an annual competition played at Kingsbarns (there is no green fee for that competition).

If you would like to go ahead with your application to join St Regulus and don't know any of our current members then please return the form with a covering note and an introductory meeting will be arranged for you. If you are already a member of a golf club then a letter of introduction would be helpful.
